



CO 82 IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT GLENWOOD SPRINGS TO CARBONDALE

AUGUST 12-18 TRAFFIC UPDATE - REVISED

Milling and paving work begins Tuesday, August 13 - Go slow for the ConeZone!

- Asphalt milling begins on Tuesday, August 13 at mile point 2.5 on eastbound CO 82 (upvalley at the Glenwood Springs city limits).
- Paving operations are scheduled to begin on Thursday, August 15.
- Crews will remove the surface of the asphalt driving lanes and add a new layer of asphalt to even out the road surface at peeling and rutted areas.
- Motorists should anticipate stretches of shoulder closures, lane closures, reduced speed limits and narrowed roads during daylight hours.
- The width restriction in work areas is 10'.
- The work areas will generally be shifting in a stairstep pattern with work occurring first in the left passing lane then in the right travel lane. Delays are anticipated.
- Paving operations between 24th Street in Glenwood Springs and mile point 12, just past the main Carbondale exit, are expected to be complete by October.

There are several areas where lane closures will mean narrow travel lanes. It is critical that motorists follow the reduced speed signage in the work areas to keep both fellow motorists and crews safe on the project. Give the road your full attention. Don't be on your cell phones, look out for others vehicles, and please, watch for flaggers and workers.

Guardrail replacement, utility work and curb/ramp improvements along Colorado Highway 82 is ongoing. Please use both lanes until the merge point.

Construction Work Hours and Lane Restriction Hours

Construction hours are 6 AM to 9 PM on weekdays. In order to minimize impacts to the traveling public, there will be no lane closures during the morning peak for the eastbound/upvalley lanes (towards Aspen, 6-9 AM) or during the afternoon peak for the westbound/downvalley lanes (towards Glenwood Springs, 3-7 PM).
