

RESOLUTION 2013-7

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENWOOD SPRINGS, COLORADO, CANCELLING THE REGULAR MUNICIPAL MAIL BALLOT ELECTION FOR WARD 2 AND WARD 5 COUNCILMEMBER SEATS SCHEDULED FOR APRIL 2, 2013.

WHEREAS, in Resolution 2012-27 the City Council adopted the requirements and procedures of the Uniform Election Code of 1992 for the mail ballot election for the April 2, 2013 regular municipal election; and

WHEREAS, the following three nonpartisan offices were open for the municipal election scheduled for April 2, 2013: At-Large Councilmember, Ward 2 Councilmember, and Ward 5 Councilmember; and

WHEREAS, according to the certification of the City Clerk, only one candidate has submitted a petition and no write-in candidates have come forward for the following offices: Ward 2 Councilmember and Ward 5 Councilmember; and

WHEREAS, the ballot question submitted for a city-wide vote at the April 2, 2013 municipal election remains on the ballot; and

WHEREAS, Subsection 1-5-208(1.5) of the Uniform Election Code of 1992 permits the cancellation of an election if, at the close of business on the sixty-third day before the election, there are not more candidates than offices to be filled, including candidates filing affidavits of intent.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENWOOD SPRINGS, COLORADO, THAT:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Glenwood Springs hereby authorizes the City Clerk to cancel the April 2, 2013 election for Ward 2 Councilmember and Ward 5 Councilmember, declare the candidates elected and publish notice of cancellation, as set forth in the Uniform Election Code of 1992.

Section 2. Two qualified candidates having petitioned in proper form for the election for the office of At-Large Councilmember shall proceed as previously scheduled.

Section 3. The ballot question submitted for a vote shall proceed as previously scheduled.


