

RESOLUTION 2013-8

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENWOOD SPRINGS, COLORADO, AUTHORIZING AND SUPPORTING THE APPLICATION FOR A GRANT FROM THE GARFIELD COUNTY FEDERAL MINERAL LEASE DISTRICT FOR THE 29TH STREET AND SOPRIS AVENUE WATERLINE REPLACEMENT, DRAINAGE STRUCTURES, AND STREET RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the waterlines and street surfaces of 29th Street and Sopris Avenue have degraded to a point where replacement is necessary for the safety of the citizens of the City and Garfield County; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Glenwood Springs finds that replacing the waterline, rebuilding the road surfaces, and adding drainage structures would benefit the citizens of the City and Garfield County; and

WHEREAS, the City Council supports the application for a grant from the Garfield County Federal Mineral Lease District for replacement of the 29th Street and Sopris Avenue waterlines, drainage structures, and street sections in an amount not to exceed Three Hundred Forty-Three Thousand Dollars (\$343,000.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENWOOD SPRINGS, COLORADO, THAT:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Glenwood Springs strongly supports the Garfield County Federal Mineral Lease District grant application for replacement of the 29th Street and Sopris Avenue waterline, drainage structures, and street sections.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of Glenwood Springs authorizes the expenditure of funds necessary to meet the terms and obligations of any Garfield County Federal Mineral Lease District grant awarded.

Section 3. The waterlines, drainage structures, and roadways are owned by the City of Glenwood Springs and will be owned by the City of Glenwood Springs for the next twenty-five (25) years.

Section 4. The City of Glenwood Springs will continue to maintain the waterlines, drainage structures, and roadways in a high quality condition and will appropriate funds for maintenance in its annual budget.

Section 5. If the grant is awarded, the City of Glenwood Springs hereby authorizes the Mayor to sign the grant agreement with Garfield County Federal Mineral Lease District.


Section 6. This Resolution to be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
