RESOLUTION 2013-14

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENWOOD SPRINGS, COLORADO, ACTING AS THE ELECTRIC UTILITY BOARD, SETTING ELECTRIC RATES.

WHEREAS, Article 080.050 of the City's Municipal Code provides that fees for electric rates be set by Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Glenwood Springs, acting as the Electric Utility Board, has made the following findings of fact:

- 1. The most recent adjustment to the City of Glenwood Springs Electric System rates was approved in May 2012. Since that time, the City's operating costs and the costs of purchased power have increased, and routine capital projects are required due to normal wear and tear over time. Further, there is a need to construct a new building to house the electric department operations.
- 2. The Western Area Power Association Credit Adjustment is being repealed due to a reduction of power generation from WAPA, and due to cost increases of power from WAPA.
- 3. The City Council is in receipt of information upon which it bases its decision to now increase electric rates and to repeal the WAPA Credit Adjustment as set forth in Advice Letter No. 24 of the City Manager dated May 14, 2013, with attached Tariff Sheets.
- 4. The Tariff Sheets proposed in Advice Letter No. 24 represent fair and equitable charges for electric service in the City of Glenwood Springs in order for the Electric System to realize the historical rate of return of the System. The proposed Schedule of Rates is in the public interest and should be authorized.

WHEREAS, the Electric Utility Board has, prior to the adoption of this resolution, given public notice pursuant to Rule 17(A)(1) of the Rules of Practice and Procedure before the Electric Utility Board of the City of Glenwood Springs, Colorado; and

WHEREAS, the City Council by this Resolution will set electric rates until otherwise amended by City Council, and repeals the WAPA Credit Adjustment.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENWOOD SPRINGS, COLORADO, ACTING AS THE ELECTRIC UTILITY BOARD, THAT:

Section 1. It hereby adopts the revised schedule of electric rates and repeal of the WAPA Credit Adjustment recommended by the City Manager in Advice Letter No. 24. Copies of the Advice Letter and the revised schedule sheets shall be available for public inspection in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Glenwood Springs, Colorado.

Section 2. The electric rates set forth in the revised rate schedules shall be effective for all electric utility billing performed by the Glenwood Springs Electric System for the July 2013 electric billing cycle.
