

## **RESOLUTION 2013-20**

### **A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENWOOD SPRINGS, COLORADO, AUTHORIZING AND SUPPORTING THE APPLICATION FOR A MINI-GRANT FROM THE GARFIELD COUNTY FEDERAL MINERAL LEASE DISTRICT FOR AN EVALUATION OF THE PAVEMENT SECTION AND EXISTING ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY ON MIDLAND AVENUE FROM 27<sup>TH</sup> STREET TO FOUR MILE ROAD.**

**WHEREAS**, Midland Avenue from 27<sup>th</sup> Street to Four Mile Road is heavily used by the citizens of the City and Garfield County, which is expected to increase in the future; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Glenwood Springs finds that an evaluation of the current condition of the pavement and the existing road right-of-way is necessary to accommodate the existing and future volume of traffic on that section of Midland Avenue and would benefit the citizens of the City and Garfield County; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council supports the application for a mini-grant from the Garfield County Federal Mineral Lease District for an evaluation of the pavement section and existing road right-of-way on Midland Avenue from 27<sup>th</sup> Street to Four Mile Road in an amount not to exceed Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00).

### **NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENWOOD SPRINGS, COLORADO, THAT:**

**Section 1.** The City Council of the City of Glenwood Springs strongly supports the Garfield County Federal Mineral Lease District mini-grant application for an evaluation of the pavement section and existing road right-of-way on Midland Avenue from 27<sup>th</sup> Street to Four Mile Road.

**Section 2.** Midland Avenue is owned by the City of Glenwood Springs and will be owned and maintained by the City of Glenwood Springs for the next twenty-five (25) years.




**Section 4.** This Resolution to be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
