

RESOLUTION 2013-23

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENWOOD SPRINGS, COLORADO, SUPPORTING THE GRANT APPLICATION FOR A LOCAL PARKS AND OUTDOOR RECREATION GRANT FROM THE STATE BOARD OF THE GREAT OUTDOORS COLORADO TRUST FUND FOR PLAYGROUND IMPROVEMENTS AT GLENWOOD SPRINGS ELEMENTARY SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, the Roaring Fork School District is interested in updating the playground and playground equipment at Glenwood Springs Elementary School and has requested the City of Glenwood Springs submit a grant application on its' behalf to the State Board; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Glenwood Springs finds that submitting a grant application to the State Board of the Great Outdoors Colorado Trust Fund on behalf of the School District would benefit the City of Glenwood Springs.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENWOOD SPRINGS, COLORADO, THAT:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Glenwood Springs strongly supports the Great Outdoors Colorado grant application for playground improvements at Glenwood Springs Elementary School, on behalf of the Roaring Fork School District.

Section 2. Roaring Fork School District has appropriated matching funds for a grant with Great Outdoors Colorado, and authorizes the expenditure of funds necessary to meet the terms and obligations of any grant awarded.

Section 3. If the grant is awarded, the City Council of the City of Glenwood Springs strongly supports completion of the project.

Section 4. Glenwood Springs Elementary School is owned by the Roaring Fork School District and will be owned by the Roaring Fork School District for the next twenty-five (25) years.

Section 5. The Roaring Fork School District will continue to maintain the Glenwood Springs Elementary School playground in a high quality condition.

Section 6. If the grant is awarded, the City Council of the City of Glenwood Springs authorizes the Mayor or Mayor Pro Tem to sign the grant agreement with Great Outdoors Colorado.


Section 7. This Resolution to be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
