## **RESOLUTION 2013-24**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENWOOD SPRINGS, COLORADO, AUTHORIZING AND SUPPORTING THE APPLICATION FOR A LOCAL PARKS AND OUTDOOR RECREATION GRANT FROM THE STATE BOARD OF THE GREAT OUTDOORS COLORADO TRUST FUND FOR PLANNING SHORELINE RESTORATION AND ENHANCEMENTS AT TWO RIVERS PARK AND VELTUS PARK.

**WHEREAS**, Two Rivers Park and Veltus Park are highly used community parks located on the Colorado and Roaring Fork Rivers; and

**WHEREAS**, the shorelines at Two Rivers Park and Veltus Park have degraded to a point where restoration and rehabilitation are necessary; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Glenwood Springs finds that a master plan and site plan for the riverbank areas are necessary to address the existing and future demands of these parks and would benefit the citizens and visitors to the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Glenwood Springs finds that submitting a grant application to the State Board of the Great Outdoors Colorado Trust Fund would benefit the citizens and visitors of the City.

## NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENWOOD SPRINGS, COLORADO, THAT:

- **Section 1.** The City Council of the City of Glenwood Springs strongly supports the Great Outdoors Colorado grant application for planning shoreline restoration and enhancements at Two Rivers Park and Veltus Park.
- **Section 2.** The City of Glenwood Springs has appropriated matching funds for a grant with Great Outdoors Colorado, and authorizes the expenditure of funds necessary to meet the terms and obligations of any grant awarded.
- **Section 3.** If the grant is awarded, the City Council of the City of Glenwood Springs strongly supports completion of the project.

**Section 4.** If the grant is awarded, the City Council of the City of Glenwood Springs authorizes the Mayor or Mayor Pro Tem to sign the grant agreement with Great Outdoors Colorado.

Section 5. This Resolution to be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
