

RESOLUTION 2013-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENWOOD SPRINGS, COLORADO, APPROVING THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE GARFIELD COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER FOR A COORDINATED ELECTION FOR THE NOVEMBER 5, 2013 ELECTION.

WHEREAS, in Resolution 2013-17 the City Council of the City of Glenwood Springs authorized that the election of November 5, 2013 be conducted as a coordinated election, appointed the Garfield County Clerk and Recorder as the Coordinated Election Official, and appointed the Glenwood Springs City Clerk as the Election Officer for the City of Glenwood Springs; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Colorado Constitution Article XIV, Section 18(2)(a), and Colorado Revised Statute Sections 29-1-203 and 1-7-116(2), as amended, the City of Glenwood Springs and the Garfield County Clerk and Recorder are required to enter into an agreement to conduct a coordinated election; and

WHEREAS, the final Intergovernmental Agreement regarding the conduct of the coordinated election has now been received from the Garfield County Clerk and Recorder and a copy is attached hereto and incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S 1-7-116(2), as amended, the agreement shall be signed no later than seventy (70) days prior to the scheduled election.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENWOOD SPRINGS, COLORADO, THAT:

The City Council of the City of Glenwood Springs hereby approves and authorizes the Mayor or Mayor Pro Tem to sign the attached Intergovernmental Agreement concerning the November 5, 2013 coordinated election.
