

RESOLUTION 2013-30

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENWOOD SPRINGS, COLORADO, SUPPORTING THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, DIVISION OF TRANSIT AND RAIL, GRANT APPLICATION FOR THE PROVISION OF A TRANSIT PLANNING PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the State of Colorado, Department of Transportation, has obtained certain unencumbered Federal funds for the provision of a transit planning project; and

WHEREAS, the State Department of Transportation, Division of Transit and Rail, is responsible for the disbursement of those funds; and

WHEREAS, the City of Glenwood Springs desires to submit an application for funds available for a transit planning project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Glenwood Springs finds it appropriate to apply for a grant from the Colorado Department of Transportation for a transit planning project in the amount of not more than Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000.00), including a local match to be expended in 2014 of not more than Eight Thousand Dollars (\$8,000.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENWOOD SPRINGS, COLORADO, THAT:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Glenwood Springs authorizes and supports the submission of the Colorado Department of Transportation grant application for a transit planning project.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of Glenwood Springs authorizes the expenditure of funds necessary to meet the terms and obligations of a Colorado Department of Transportation grant awarded in an amount not to exceed Eight Thousand Dollars (\$8,000.00).


Section 3. This Resolution to be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
