No Boat Trailer Parking at Two Rivers During GAB Detour

GLENWOOD SPRINGS, CO – Boat trailer parking will not be allowed at Two Rivers Park during the Grand Avenue Bridge (GAB) Detour, starting August 14. This decision was made to allow for additional room for school buses to pick up and drop off, as well as for vanpool parking. The City of Glenwood Springs is creating a new parking lot nearby at the Centennial right-of-way, next to Iron Mountain Hot Springs. Any vehicle with a boat trailer attached will be required to park at this new lot, which will accommodate up to seven vehicles with trailers on a first come, first served basis. The Centennial lot will also accommodate about 60 additional vehicles without trailers.

The City of Glenwood Springs has created several other parking lots for use during the Grand Avenue Bridge Detour. In addition to the new Centennial lot, temporary public parking lots have been created at the West Glenwood Mall and at Vogelaar Park. And thanks to the generosity of our community partners, public parking will also be available at RFTA's park and ride, Safeway, Walmart, Glenwood Meadows, and American Furniture Warehouse. Any of these locations will be a great place to park your car and continue your commute via bike, bus, or walking.

What parking will be available during the Bridge Detour?

Southside of I-70:

- Former waste-water treatment plant parking lot on 7th St.
- Triangle-shaped parking lot just west of City Hall
- Lot at 7th Street and Colorado
- Parking structure at 9th/Cooper
- Cooper St parking lot (between 8th & 9th)
- Safeway parking (in back)
- Walmart parking (in back)
- RFTA parking lot at Highway 82 and 27th Street
- Wulfsohn RTFA park and ride
- Glenwood Meadows

Northside Parking:

- West Glenwood Mall
- Two Rivers Park
- Centennial lot (next to Iron Mountain Hot Springs)

After 6 p.m. Public Parking:

- Vogelaar Park, next to YouthZone
- Garfield County Courthouse
- Library/CMC parking garage

During the GAB Detour, parking will not be allowed on 8th street, or on Colorado Avenue between 8th and 9th streets. Parking in public lots will be limited to 14 hours, with the exception of the triangle-shaped lot, just west of City Hall (2-hour parking). Anyone parking in lots that become public parking after 6 pm, like the Vogelaar Park lot next to YouthZone, will need to move their vehicle before 7am. Failure to do so may result in a citation and/or the vehicle being towed.

Where can I park my bicycle?

The City of Glenwood Springs has purchased and is installing several new bicycle racks. To help you find a safe spot to lock up your bike, City staff have created a handy new interactive map layer that shows the locations of bike racks throughout town.
