Fire Restrictions Lifted in City of Glenwood Springs

GLENWOOD SPRINGS, CO – Due to recent rain fall and cooler temperatures, the City of Glenwood Springs has lifted fire restrictions, effective immediately.

Stage 1 fire restrictions have also been lifted throughout Garfield County on private and public lands, including the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) and the White River National Forest.

The City of Glenwood Springs would like to thank residents and visitors for their cooperation this summer during a heightened fire danger season.

City officials would also like to remind the public that the sale and use of fireworks in City limits is prohibited throughout the year, even without fire restrictions in place. Additionally, the City has several smoking restrictions in place all year.

Smoking is always prohibited:

- Within fifty (50) feet of any child care center or school
- In the downtown area, between the hours of 5:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m.
- Within twenty-five (25) feet of a transit stop
- In any park, parkland, or recreation area or facility
- Within twenty-five (25) feet of any common, active, or passive open space
