

RESOLUTION NO. 2013-4

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
GLENWOOD SPRINGS, COLORADO, AUTHORIZING
A SOLE SOURCE PROCUREMENT OF FARE CARD
READING EQUIPMENT FOR THE RIDE GLENWOOD
SPRINGS TRANSIT SYSTEM.**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Glenwood Springs, in Resolution No. 2012-11, previously authorized a sole source procurement of fare card reading equipment for the Ride Glenwood Springs transit system in conjunction with a grant award from the Colorado Department of Transportation (“CDOT”); and

WHEREAS, due to a redesign of one component, the equipment delivery could not be fulfilled prior to the expiration of the CDOT grant contract; and

WHEREAS, recently City staff filed another grant application to CDOT for the full purchase price of the fare card reading equipment, which has now been approved; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Glenwood Springs, Colorado is authorized to acquire, dispose of, and encumber real and personal property necessary to the functions or the operation for the City; and

WHEREAS, Section 010.050.110 of the Municipal Code provides that, after good faith review of available sources and with the recommendation of the City Manager, City Council may by resolution authorize the purchase of property without competitive bidding.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF GLENWOOD SPRINGS, COLORADO, THAT:**

Section 1. City Council finds that a good faith review of available sources has been sufficiently completed.

Section 2. The Public Works Director or other appropriate City official is authorized to purchase fare card reading equipment for the Ride Glenwood Springs transit system in the amount of Fifty-Six Thousand One Hundred Ninety-Five Dollars (\$56,195.00).

Section 3. Purchase of the fare card reading equipment will be from funds awarded to the City from the Colorado Department of Transportation under a grant contract dated December 6, 2012, no local match is required.


