

RESOLUTION 2013-5

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENWOOD SPRINGS, COLORADO, AUTHORIZING THE SOLICITATION OF A SEALED COMPETITIVE PROPOSAL FOR AUDIO VIDEO CONTROL SYSTEM FOR CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS.

WHEREAS, the procedure to authorize the solicitation of sealed competitive proposals for goods and services is provided for in Section 010.050.100 of the Glenwood Springs Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended that the City Council determine that the use of competitive sealed bidding for an audio video control system for City Council chambers is not practicable or not advantageous to the City, and the contract may be entered into by use of a competitive sealed proposal; and

WHEREAS, the City Council expressly finds that the use of a competitive sealed proposal is advantageous to the City in that the marketplace will respond better to a solicitation permitting not only a range of alternative proposals but evaluation and discussion of them before making an award; and

WHEREAS, the competitive sealed proposal process will permit the City to assign the relative importance of price and other factors in evaluating the qualitative aspects of the proposals.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENWOOD SPRINGS, COLORADO, THAT:

Pursuant to Section 010.050.100 of the Glenwood Springs Municipal Code, the City Manager is hereby authorized to solicit competitive proposals for an audio video control system for City Council Chambers. A copy of this Resolution shall be made a part of the contract file.
