



CO 82 and CO 133 Signal Replacement Project

Traffic Update: June 7 to June 11

Ongoing Traffic Impacts

The signal replacement project on CO 82/Grand Avenue will begin at Mile Point 0.18 and MP 1.43 at 11th Street and 14th Street and on CO 133 at MP 66.05 and MP 68.82 at Village Road and Meadowood Drive. Motorists should plan for:

- **Monday 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.**
 - CO 82 and 11th Street northbound no right turn and southbound left turn lane closure: 11th Street closed from CO 82 to Cooper Avenue.
 - CO 133 at Meadowood Drive eastbound right turn lane closure.
- **Tuesday 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.**
 - CO 82 and 11th Street northbound left turn lane closure and southbound no right turn: 11th Street closed from CO 82 to Colorado Avenue.
 - CO 133 at Meadowood Drive westbound right turn lane closure and southbound right acceleration lane closure.
- **Wednesday 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.**
 - CO 82 and 11th Street northbound no right turn and southbound left turn lane closure: 11th Street closed from CO 82 to Cooper Avenue.
- **Thursday 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.**
 - CO 82 and 11th Street northbound left turn lane closure and southbound no right turn: 11th Street closed from CO 82 to Colorado Avenue.
- **Friday 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.**
 - CO 82 and 14th Street northbound no right turn and southbound left turn lane closure: 14th Street closed from CO 82 to Cooper Avenue.

Business access will be maintained and pedestrian traffic will be accommodated.

Work will consist of sidewalk removals, drilling and pouring caissons.
